

**Transfer Agreement**  
**Between American National University and the International American University**

**I. PURPOSE**

This agreement is designed to coordinate transfer policies, define the terms of admissions, academic advising, and promote the acceptance of equivalent courses/credits between ("ANU") and the International American University ("IAU").

**II. ELEMENTS OF THE AGREEMENT**

**A. Admissions Practices**

1. American National University will accept applications from students who wish to transfer from the International American University into any graduate level business program at ANU. Transferring IAU applicants must meet the same admissions criteria as other students applying for transfer to ANU. Completion of IAU's English as a Second Language program satisfies ANU's entrance requirements for International students.
2. Students transferring from IAU to specific ANU programs must meet the same prerequisites, grade point average (GPA) and other admission criteria, as other native or transfer students applying to ANU programs. Semester hour credits are subject to conversion to quarter hour credits at a ratio of 4:3.
3. IAU students who graduate with Bachelor of Business Administration degree and have an IAU cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 are accepted for admission to American National University. ANU will accept all credits included in the official transcript of the degree program from which the student has graduated, including credits from previous institutions and credits from nontraditional sources such as high school Advanced Placement (AP) or College-Level Examination Programs (CLEP) programs.
4. IAU students who graduate with a Bachelor's of Business Administration in and have an IAU cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 will be accepted for admission to the graduate school of American National University on the same basis as other native, transfer or graduate students applying to ANU graduate programs.
5. For the purposes of admission and credit recognition the transfer GPA is equivalent to the cumulative GPA denoted on the IAU transcript.

**B. Update/Report/Relationship**

American National University and International American University agree to review the agreement and relevant transfer course equivalencies annually. ANU will designate an individual to serve as liaison for the purposes of monitoring this agreement. Each institution will provide updated catalogs to the other immediately upon their availability. American National University agrees to provide reports of enrolled International American University transfer students, their majors and academic performance when 10 or more are enrolled in any given year.

**C. Amendments and Term of Effect**


1. The catalog in effect at the time a student first enrolls at American National University will be honored by ANU if the student completes a Bachelor's Degree and successfully transfers to ANU presuming all current accreditation and regulatory standards of the respective institutions are met.

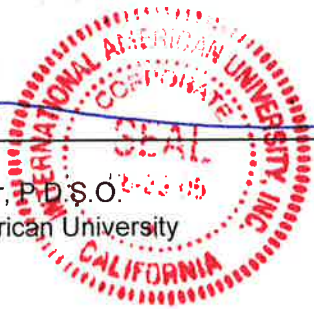


2. This agreement may be amended, as needed, for specific program articulation without affecting the currency of the master agreement.
