



Articulation Agreement Between American National University and Graduate University of Mongolia

Parties: The parties to this Agreement are American National University and Graduate University of Mongolia.

Effective Date: This Agreement goes into effect on the last date it is signed by the Parties.

Terms:

This Agreement defines the terms agreed to by the parties regarding holders of a Business Management Certificate from GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA and their eligibility to transfer to American National University. It is agreed that those individuals who receive a Business Management Certificate and meet all of the criteria listed below will be accepted without further review of credentials, with sophomore standing at American National University in the MBA in Business Administration degree program contingent on the program taken as indicated in the Appendix. This program to program arrangement will be referred to herein as the Program.

The criteria that shall be met by students participating in this Program are as follows:

- a. The student will have received a certificate in Business Management at GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA on or after the effective date of this Agreement.
- b. The student will have taken all of the required courses listed in Appendix A and incorporated herein by this reference.
- c. The student's cumulative grade point ratio must be 2.0 or higher.
- d. A grade of "C", or above, is required in all courses to be applied toward the master's degree enrolling in.
- e. The student must have taken all the courses in English at Graduate University in order to meet the requirements for admission into the MBA program at American National University.

Both GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA and American National University agree to the following responsibilities:

- a. Both parties will use best efforts to inform potential students about the program. Examples of possible informational activities may include, but are not limited to, media announcements, brochures or fliers, information sessions for students at GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA.
- b. Minor curriculum changes are made at the intersection of the departments of both GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA and American National University.
- c. The term of this Agreement will be 5 years from the effective date. The parties can renew this agreement by mutual written agreement for additional 5 year terms. Either party can terminate this agreement for any reason with a 6-month written notification. This Agreement will continue in effect until it is modified by mutual written consent of the parties or cancelled by either party. Any Student Agreements signed prior to modification, termination or ending of the term of the Agreement will be honored by both parties.
- d. This Agreement will be construed in accordance with the laws of the United States and Mongolia.

Appendix A

Students will complete 6 courses of the program at the Graduate University of Mongolia in Master of Business administration of 1+1 program.

After completing 6 courses of the program, the students will enroll at American National University to complete an additional 8 courses towards a business degree. The 8 courses can be completed in 4 terms. Upon successful completion of the 32 credits at American National University by that the students will be awarded a Master in Business Administration.

GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA agrees to the following responsibilities:


- a. GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA will appoint one of its academic advisors as the individual responsible for coordinating the implementation of the Program.
- b. GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA will provide a letter indicating the school's accreditation in Mongolia.
- c. GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA will provide American National University an official transcript for each student who has completed the Business Management certificate and intends to enroll at American National University stating the medium of instruction in English.
- d. GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA will provide a current catalog to American National University with a full description of the Business Management program.
- e. GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA will provide a current description of how GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA faculties are evaluated.
- f. GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA will provide American National University documentation showing the qualifications of faculty GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA to teach in the GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA Business Management program.
- g. GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA will provide a description of the instructional facilities at the GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA.
- h. GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA will provide a description of the plan for safety and security of students, faculty, and staff at GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA.
- i. Students opting to participate in this Program will be required to meet all of the American National University transfer credit requirements in effect at the time of their most recent enrollment at GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA.

American National University agrees to the following responsibilities:

- a. American National University will accept all courses as outlined in Appendix A with a grade of "C" or above, as part of the Diploma program offered in the Business Management program at GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA.
- b. American National University will enroll students into the Masters of Business Administration plan using the information provided in the American National University Catalog in effect during the student's most recent enrollment at GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA. Transfer credits (C or higher) from GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA will be used to meet the graduation requirements outlined in Appendix A and B. (Appendix A and B will be revised annually, or as necessary to reflect curriculum changes.)
- c. The credits earned at GRADUATE UNIVERSITY OF MONGOLIA will be fully transferred to American National University without getting evaluated by third party.
- d. American National University will identify individuals within the Department who serve as the coordinator and point of contact for American National University regarding the Program.




