



Articulation Agreement Between  
American National University and  
Royal International University

**Parties:** The parties to this Agreement are American National University and Royal International University (hereinafter RIU).

**Effective Date:** This Agreement goes into effect on the last date it is signed by the Parties.

**Terms:**

This Agreement defines the terms agreed to by the parties regarding holders of a Business Management Certificate from RIU and their eligibility to transfer to American National University. It is agreed that those individuals who receive a Business Management Certificate and meet all of the criteria listed below will be accepted without further review of credentials, with junior standing at American National University in the Business Administration – Management also in MBA in Business administration degree program. This program to program arrangement will be referred to herein as the Program.

The criteria that shall be met by students participating in this Program are as follows:

- a. The student will have received a certificate in Business Management at RIU on or after the effective date of this Agreement.
- b. The student will have taken all of the required courses listed in Appendix A and B and incorporated herein by this reference.
- c. The student's cumulative grade point ratio must be 2.0 or higher.
- d. A grade of "C", or above, is required in all courses to be applied toward the bachelor's degree.
- e. The student must have taken all the courses in English at Royal International University in order to meet the requirements for admission into the Business Administration - Management and MBA program at American National University.

Both RIU and American National University agree to the following responsibilities:

- a. Both parties will use best efforts to inform potential students about the program. Examples of possible informational activities may include, but are not limited to, media announcements, brochures or fliers, information sessions for students at RIU.
- b. Minor curriculum changes are made at the intersection of the departments of both RIU and American National University.
- c. The term of this Agreement will be 5 years from the effective date. The parties can renew this agreement by mutual written agreement for additional 5 year terms. Either party can terminate this agreement for any reason with a 6-month written notification. This Agreement will continue in effect until it is modified by mutual written consent of the parties or cancelled by either party. Any Student Agreements signed prior to modification, termination or ending of the term of the Agreement will be honored by both parties.

d. This Agreement will be construed in accordance with the laws of the United States and Mongolia.


RIU agrees to the following responsibilities:

- a. RIU will appoint one of its academic advisors as the individual responsible for coordinating the implementation of the Program.
- b. RIU will provide a letter indicating the school's accreditation in Mongolia.
- c. RIU will provide American National University an official transcript for each student who has completed the Business Management certificate and intends to enroll at American National University stating the medium of instruction in English.
- d. RIU will provide a current catalog to American National University with a full description of the Business Management program.
- e. RIU will provide a current description of how RIU faculties are evaluated.
- f. RIU will provide American National University documentation showing the qualifications of RIU faculty to teach in the RIU Business Management program.
- g. RIU will provide a description of the instructional facilities at the RIU.
- h. RIU will provide a description of the plan for safety and security of students, faculty, and staff at RIU.
- i. Students opting to participate in this Program will be required to meet all of the American National University transfer credit requirements in effect at the time of their most recent enrollment at RIU.


American National University agrees to the following responsibilities:


- a. American National University will accept all courses as outlined in Appendix A and B with a grade of "C" or above, as part of the Diploma program offered in the Business Management program at RIU.
- b. American National University will enroll students into the Bachelor's in Business Administration - Management and Masters of Business Administration plan using the information provided in the American National University Catalog in effect during the student's most recent enrollment at RIU. Transfer credits (C or higher) from RIU will be used to meet the graduation requirements outlined in Appendix A and B. (Appendix A and B will be revised annually, or as necessary to reflect curriculum changes.)
- c. The credits earned at RIU will be fully transferred to American National University without getting reevaluated by third party.
- d. American National University will identify individuals within the Department who serve as the coordinator and point of contact for American National University regarding the Program.

## Appendix A

Students will complete a 22 courses of the program at the Royal International University (RIU) in Business Management of 2+2 program.

After completing 22 courses of the program, the students will enroll at American National University to complete an additional 23 courses towards a business degree. The 23 courses can be completed in 8 terms. Upon successful completion of the 23 courses at American National University the students will be awarded a Bachelor of Business Administration – Management.
