## American National University

The graduation rate, below, was calculated based on the number of first time, full time students who enrolled at such time that 150% of the normal time to graduation fell between September 1, 2018 and August 31, 2019. The gender and race/ethnicity percentages were calculated based on self-reported information from students in that group. The financial aid information was based on institutional records for those students. The students were enrolled at American National University in Salem, VA.
