

Many of you have read the information from our President, Frank Longaker, concerning the CARES Act that was recently passed by Congress and the funds to assist students who have been affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. American National University is currently working on the calculation to process the Emergency Assistance Grant funds to our students.

The amount of the grant will be determined on the Expected Family Contribution (EFC) number that is generated by the 2019-2020 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Your Expected Family Contribution (EFC) is an index number that colleges use to determine how much financial aid you are eligible to receive. Your EFC is calculated according to a formula established by law and the information from your FAFSA. The total cost – which includes tuition, fees, room and board, books and supplies, personal expenses, and transportation cost – minus your EFC is how much financial aid the school estimates you will need to attend college.

American National University chose to use the EFC index number to determine the amount of Emergency Assistance grant you are eligible to receive based on your enrollment status. There are two categories:

- Tier 1 - EFC number: 0 to 5576 Total Grant Amount: \$1200.00
- Tier 2 - EFC number: 5577 and higher Total Grant Amount: \$ 800.00

Students will be considered eligible for the grant with the below enrollment statuses during the term:

- Full-time enrollment status is a minimum of 12 credit hours
- Half-time enrollment status is a minimum of 8 credit hours*
 - *Nursing and MBA students are considered half time at a lower credit number

The total grant amount will be disbursed based on the enrollment status at the time of payment.

- Enrollment status is confirmed twice during each term:
 - 1) During census week, which is week 2.
 - 2) 8th week of the term
 - If you officially change your enrollment status during the term, a new review will be completed before the second payment is made.
- Attending students will receive four disbursements over two terms to equal total grant amount.
- Disbursements will be made twice during each term.
 - First disbursement will be made in week 3
 - Second disbursement will be made in week 8
- This process will continue through Terms 203, 204, 205 and 206, as funds remain available.

We understand the sensitivity of this matter and we are working diligently to provide the funds to you as soon as possible. To be a recipient of the grant, students must be in good standing administratively and financially.

Financial Services will be contacting students to complete the acceptance form with the amount of grant assistance that will be received and to answer any questions you may have.
